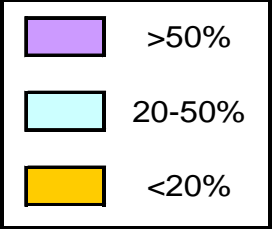
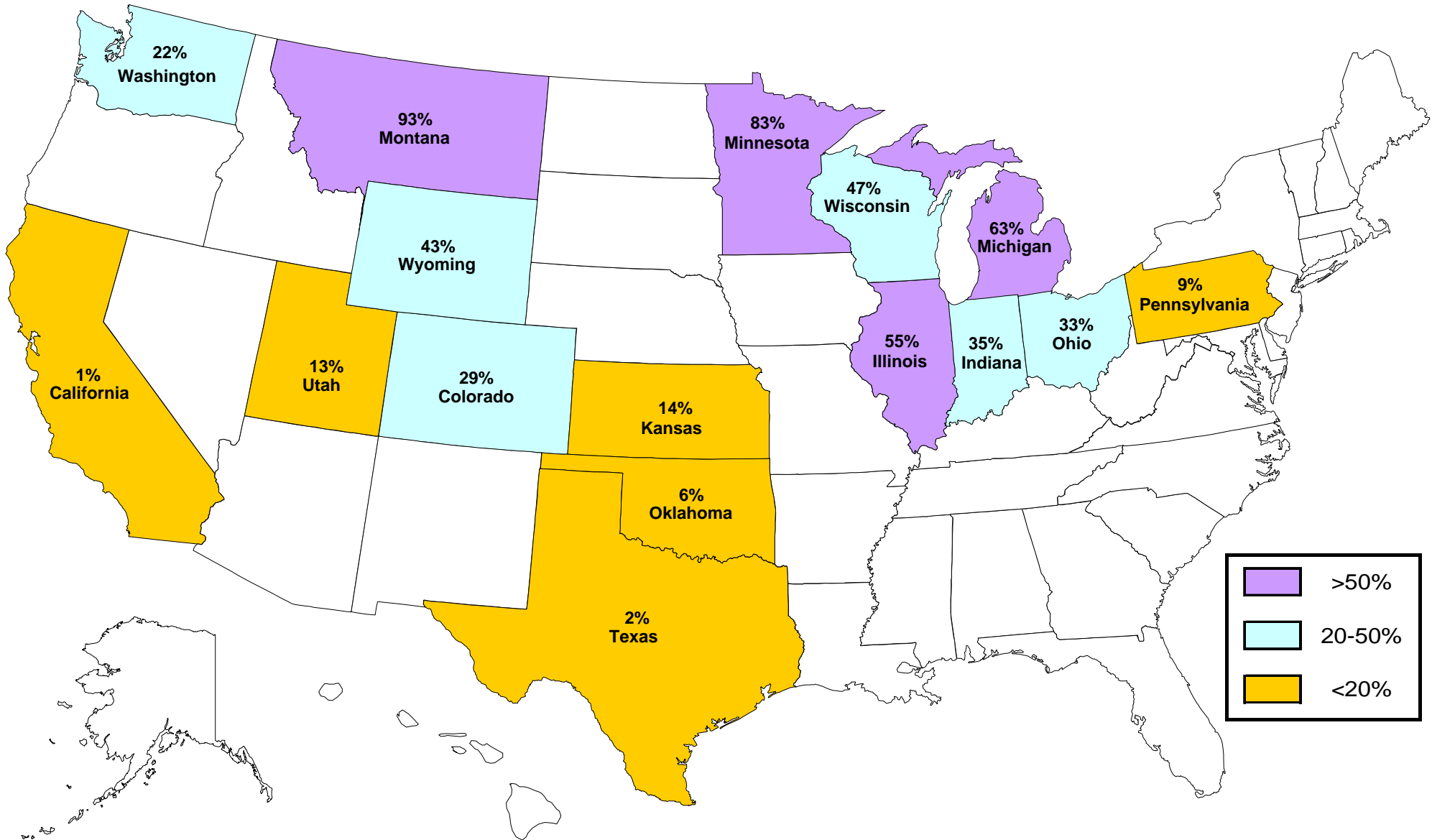


Western Canadian Crude as a Percentage of Total Crude Consumed*

This calculation takes the monthly Western Canadian Crude Consumption divided by the total refinery capacity with the capacity being adjusted using a utilization factor (utilization factor reported by the EIA, by refining district).
